

Cookie Policy

1. Information about our use of cookies

- 1.1. This policy explains how we use cookies on Rewards4Racing's website (the "Website"). We recommend that you read our cookie policy so that you are aware of how we use them and can take steps to reject or delete the cookies if you do not agree to them being used.
- 1.2. Cookies are small text files stored on your device and used by website operators in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the operators of the website or certain third parties. Each cookie usually contains a unique string of characters, which allows a website to distinguish your browser or device from other users. In this cookie policy, we also use the term "cookie" to mean any other similar technology, such as web beacons, local stored objects (such as "Flash cookies"), and pixel tags.
- 1.3. We use cookies to enable you to stay logged into your Rewards4Racing Account (including the Rewards4Racing Points Reminder, if you have downloaded it), navigate between pages and to generally improve your user experience on the Website. We also use cookies to analyse how users find and interact with the Website, to enable us to provide relevant offers to you, and to allow us to identify how our marketing campaigns have performed in general. We also sometimes use cookie type technologies in emails to identify how users come to the Website so that we can evaluate and measure the effectiveness of our email marketing.
- 1.4. We may combine information collected via cookies with information such as your IP address, the type of browser, device and operating system, for example to provide statistical information about visitors to the Website. Where the Website uses third party cookies, you should check with the relevant third party to see how they use cookies (see section 2 below).
- 1.5. You can find out more about cookies at www.allaboutCookies.org. The user instructions for your browser or device will explain how you can control the use of cookies on your device.

2. Cookies we use

We use the following cookies on the Website:

2.1. Strictly necessary cookies – These are cookies that are required for the operation of the Website.

Authentication 3	PartiallyAuthenticated	•	and password, so that we can allow you to view pages within the Website which contain personal information. This cookie is essential for us to recognise when you have 'deep linked-in' to your Account, via an email for example, so that we can block the viewing of personal information on the Website. Programme Notifications	CloseCookiePopup	•	This cookie is essential for us to provide you with programme notifications, in the form of pop-ups, so that they are only viewed once and are closed once you have accepted the message in the pop-up.	Once you have confirmed the pop-up message
Associated Partner	PartnerClub	•	This cookie is essential for us to recognise and identify the personalised content you should view, in relation to your favourite racecourse.	Once you log- out of your Account
Points Reminder	PointsReminderCookie	•	This cookie is essential for the Rewards4Racing Points Reminder to operate correctly, once you have downloaded the software. When you are logged-in to the Website, you will also be logged-in to the Points Reminder so that you can use the added benefits of the software.	Once you log- out of your Account

2.2. **Analytical / Performance cookies –** They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around the Website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way the Website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

- 2.4. **Third-party cookies** In addition to the cookies listed above, we also use the following third-party cookies for performance and functional purposes. These are cookies that are set by a third-party when you access the Website and are controlled by that third-party.

Online Shopping Authentication	Retailer Click Through & Purchase Tracking	These cookies are provided to us and controlled by our partner, Maple Syrup Media Ltd, and are essential for us to identify when you have clicked through to an online retailer (when you are logged-in to your Account). This enables us to allocate points to your Account once you have completed a Qualifying Transaction with the relevant retailer.	Up to 30 days after you have clicked through from the Website
Social Media	Facebook / Instagram / Twitter (for example)	Social networking sites such as Facebook, Instagram and Twitter may use cookies: 1) when you share content from the Website in your social media feed; and/or 2) that help them to show adverts from businesses and advertisers in your social media feed, but only if your privacy settings within your social media account allows them to do so. Since we do not have any control over your social media privacy settings, we are unable to control these cookies.
